## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### RED BEET EGGS (pickled eggs)

#### Ingredients:

8-10 eggs hard boiled, shells removed

2 15 oz cans sliced red beets

½ cup white vinegar or to taste

½ cup white sugar or to taste

Salt and pepper to taste

#### Instructions:

Place the juice from both cans of red beets in a large bowl. Add the sugar and vinegar, whisk to combine and sugar is dissolved. Add salt and pepper to taste. Add the eggs and sliced beets. Try and make sure that the eggs are covered in the juice. Refrigerate the eggs for at least two days, the longer they sit in the fridge covered in juice the better and darker they become. Store pickled in the fridge no longer than a week.
